BOOKINGS

All bookings must be made via the Parent [Portal](#) and before the specified closing date. Payment of fees must be made in full, prior to the first day of care.

EXCURSIONS

On excursion days it is important children arrive at least 20 minutes before the bus is due to leave; the bus will not wait for those who are late. On non-excursion days children can arrive at any time.

In most cases, excursions are strictly limited to 50 participants so we encourage families to book early.

WHAT TO BRING

Children are required to bring the following each day:

- ✓ Packed lunch, unless otherwise indicated on the program (do not send food that requires heating)
- ✓ Water bottle
- ✓ Clothing suitable for the day's weather
- ✓ Shoes suitable for participation in the day's activities (no Crocs or thongs)
- ✓ From 30 April - 1 September a wide brimmed hat (no baseball caps) and sunscreen is required.

NO HAT MEANS NO OUTDOOR PLAY.

- ✓ Medication, if applicable

SNACKS

Morning and afternoon tea is provided each day and water is readily available.

PAYMENTS

Payments can be made by cash, cheque, credit card or eftpos (at school office), bPay (Berwick PS families only) or by using the [Qkr](#) app.

CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations made after the closing date will result in a loss of deposit. Cancellation of care once the program has commenced will be charged in full. We do not issue refunds or credits in the case of illness or injury or where a child does not attend.

SPENDING MONEY & VALUABLES

Strictly no money or children's toys (including electronic games) are to be brought to the program. If students bring mobile phones, these must be kept in the OSHC office for the day's care. Please hand to a staff member when signing in.

We do not accept any responsibility for loss or damage to personal items that are brought to the program.

BEHAVIOUR

If a child's behaviour seriously affects the safety and/or enjoyment of others, parents will be contacted and asked to make alternative care arrangements for their child/ren.

CHILDREN WITH ADDITIONAL NEEDS

Parents of children with additional needs must contact the OSHC service on 9707 4656 at least 2 weeks before the close of booking date. It is important to allow sufficient time to discuss possible attendance and funding to best support your child's participation in the program.
